Allen Wayne Brashier, of Odessa, passed away at 11:05am Wed, August 12, 2015, at Medical Center Hospital. He was 73 years old. He was born August 25, 1941, in Buna, TX, to Edgar & Donie Brashier.

After graduation from Buna High School, Wayne served his country in the US Air Force. He especially enjoyed serving in Korea. Wayne married Lori Hudson on October 5, 1990. Affectionately called “Boo”
