Bobbie Wynell Orr age 88 of Odessa, Texas died peacefully in her home on Monday, November 7 th , 2022.

Alzheimer's took her away from her family a little more each day; however,
she never lost her wit and
grace. Bobbie loved to tell stories of the Navy life and her childhood. Everyone
who came to her house
was offered a dance lesson, whether music was playing or not. For the last 15
years, daughter Teresa was
her primary caregiver, providing love and support during that difficult time,
facing each day with
laughter and tears and an occasional, "Bobbie, what are you doing?"
