Jan Carol Mulleneaux Kator, born on November 29, 1945 in Artesia, California, passed away on October 20, 2017 at the age of 71. She graduated from Venice High School, Santa Monica CC and Long Beach State. She was the oldest of two from her parents Carl and Theresa Mulleneaux. Her father was a Green Bay Packer Hall of Fame player and she was a devoted fan of the Packers for the rest of her life. She was a mother to 5 boys, but her house was always full of children. Her front door was a revolving one for anyone who needed family and a place to be. She was extremely active in her children's lives; whether it was Pop Warner Football, Lomita Little League, or Booster President of Narbonne High School Football. She became an active volunteer with Summer MuMmers after her youngest, Erik, who was known for playing the villain in multiple seasons of MuMmers, was killed in a tragic motorcycle accident. She married the love of her life, David L. Kator, on February 28, 1976. She spent most of her life in California, but moved to Midland in 2002. She is preceded in death by her mother, father and her youngest son, Erik Kator. She is survived by her brother Carl Mulleneaux (and Barbara), her husband David, her 4 sons: Sean Kator, Mike Mulleneaux, Mark Kator (and Elizabeth), and David Kator II (and Halie Haley); along with 14 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren.
