



Lino Joel Garcia, Sr.

May 4, 1958 - November 4, 2023

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of a remarkable man, Rev. Lino Joel Garcia Sr. Lino departed this world on November 3, 2023, and leaves behind a legacy of love, faith, and enduring strength.

Lino was a man of many talents and unwavering determination. There was nothing he couldn't fix and nothing he couldn't do. He proudly graduated from Odessa High School in 1975 and embarked on a journey of hard work and self-improvement that would define his remarkable life. He held various positions, from working at Idealco Insulation to General Tire. He also pursued higher education at DeVry University in Texas and received certificates from Texas Bible College. Lino's entrepreneurial spirit led him to establish his own business, Alpha Overhead Door Inc, in 2001, which grew to become a testament to his perseverance and dedication.

But it was in the spiritual realm that Lino found his true calling and purpose. In November 1998, he encountered the Lord Jesus Christ, and in January 1999, he was baptized in the beautiful name of Jesus (Acts 2:38). This marked the beginning of a profound spiritual journey. Lino loved the Lord with all his heart and found his soulmate, Mary Sue Loe, while doing the Lord's work. They exchanged their vows in June 2000 and embarked on a shared path of faith and love.

Lino was first and foremost a devoted worshipper, servant, giver, usher, soul winner, and a minister for the Lord Jesus. He earned his minister's license through the United Pentecostal Church International and dedicated himself to

spreading the word of God and helping others find their way to salvation. His faith and commitment touched the lives of countless individuals.

In addition to his religious calling, Lino was an adventurer who relished the great outdoors. He enjoyed 4-wheelers, camping, and traveling with his family in their RV to various church camps. From the Rocky Mountains to the Appalachian Mountains, Lino and his family explored the beauty of the world together, seeking joy, peace, and love in their travels.

Sadly, Lino's ministry was cut short by a 4-wheeler accident in August 2014. Despite this setback, he remained resilient, enduring nine years of hospital visits, primarily due to complications from liver failure. He fought a courageous battle, demonstrating unwavering strength and determination throughout his ordeal. Now, as Lino departs from this world, we honor his memory and celebrate his life of victory.

Lino is survived by his loving wife, Mary Sue, with whom he shared over two decades of happiness. He leaves behind a precious legacy in his seven children: Lorissa Garcia Lopez (husband Eric), Marlina Garcia, Eliza Garcia, Kelsee Garcia, bonus daughter Jasmyne Lopez (husband Emilio), Amanda Garcia, Lino Garcia Jr. (wife Holly), and JoVanna Garcia Gasnarez (husband Julian).

Lino is also survived by his father, Rogerio Molina Garcia, as well as his brothers and sisters: Roy Garcia (Sylvia), Belinda Garcia Acosta (Ricky), Rev. Ruben Garcia (Lucy) and Dee Jakob (late husband Dave)
