Lynette Marie THOMAS

(née Matchim) of Odessa, Texas, passed away at 51 years of age on December 08, 2022 at her home in Odessa, Texas after a battle with cancer.

Lynette was born in Goose Bay, Labrador, Canada at the American Base Hospital on May 5, 1971. Her father Ralph in the Military was then moved to Sydney, Nova Scotia, St. John's, Newfoundland then Edmonton, Alberta where she went to Queen Elizabeth High School and then on to University of Alberta to finish a nursing BScN degree. She graduated in 1993 and was recruited with her best friend from university, Theresa Roy's (née Whitehead) to work at Odessa Regional Medical Center where she was employed for close to 30 years in various positions throughout the hospital. During this time she received awards in 2003 for Registered Nurse of the Year and in 2007 for Emergency Nurse of the Year.

Lynette met her best friend and the love of her life, Andrew Thomas of Odessa, Texas and they were married in February 2000. They were together

for 29 years.

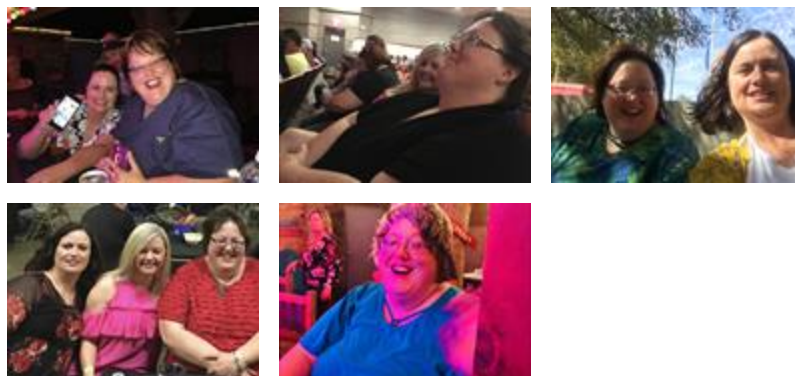
