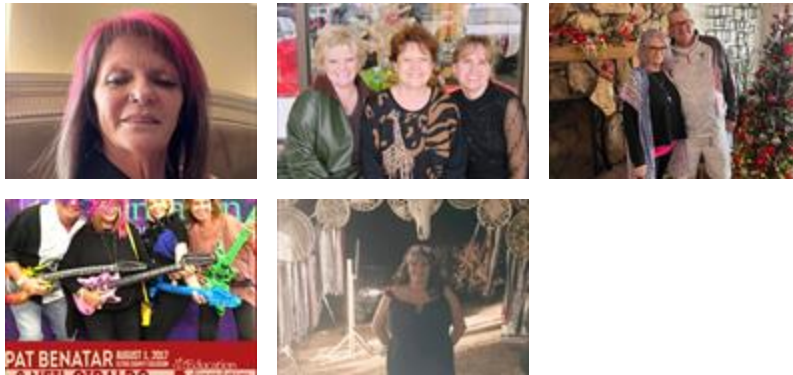
*I'm so sorry Mark. I know you are lost. I just found out and it's Aug 20th. We love you and are here if you ever need us.*
