Melvin is survived by his four children, Toni Holland (Bob) of Birmingham, AL, Chet Winn Clark (Tammy) of Seminole, TX, Michelle Marie Colson (James), and Rachael Marie Stout of Midland, TX; eight grandchildren, Ian Gage (Deborah), Andrew Gage (Rhinnon), Jonathan Gage (Kristin), Aaron Burrell, Mandy Danley (Todd), Josh Clark (Crystal), Eric Clark (Melissa), and Monica Booth; ten great-grandchildren; and his brother, Hulen Clark.
