Dr. Michael Mark Hawley, 74, of Midland, Texas entered the presence of his Lord and Savior on April 24, 2026. He was born on December 16, 1951 in Washington, Missouri to Dean and Verna Hawley.

Michael received Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior at the young age of five and surrendered to preach at the age of 10. He started serving as Senior Pastor in Baptist Churches at 21. Even though he retired as Senior Pastor 45 years later, he never retired from serving the Lord. He served two churches in Texas as Interim Pastor and his beautiful tenor voice rang out in the choir at First Baptist Church, Midland, Texas until his last Sunday on earth.

Michael lived an exuberant life full of love for his family, his friends, and for his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He was a gifted teacher who held a deep love of seeing others grow in their knowledge of the Word of God.

Michael was preceded in death by his parents, Dean and Verna Hawley; his brother, Carroll; and two sisters, Becky and Christina Kay.

He is survived by his bride of 53 years, Maryjane; two dearly loved sons, Michael Aaron Hawley (Lauren) and Jonathan Alan Hawley (Heather); four precious grandchildren: Michael Shiloh, Alice Caroline, Wyatt Dean, and Cyrus Levi; two siblings, Patricia Raines (David) and Angela Gray; and many
