Patricia Jo Campbell Eicher McCallum, lovingly known as “Patty,” passed away peacefully on March 26th, 2025, in Lubbock, Texas, just two days shy of her 66th birthday. She was born on March 28th, 1959, in Odessa, Texas, where she spent the entirety of her life surrounded by the people and places she loved most.

Patty was the embodiment of creativity, strength, and compassion. A proud graduate of Permian High School’s Class of 1977, she later went on to earn two bachelor’s degrees—from the University of Texas of the Permian Basin—in History and Art.

Throughout her life, she wore many hats: homemaker, educator, and, ultimately, a passionate real estate agent. She found joy in helping others and officially retired from real estate in 2023 after over a decade of dedicated service.

Her creativity shined in every facet of her life—from handmade costumes for her children to beautifully crafted works of art. Her daughter fondly remembers a poodle skirt Patty spent days making for her and all of the projects their mother helped them complete for school.

Patty dabbled in everything from paper making and sculpting to painting and

drawing. Her green thumb was well known, and her greenhouse was one of her sanctuaries. She had a talent for making any house feel like home, especially through her cooking—her family swears she never made a bad meal.

Patty had a lifelong love for collecting rocks and stones, a passion sparked in childhood that continued into her adult years.

Her heart was especially tender for animals, particularly dogs. Her family imagines she was welcomed to Heaven by a joyful herd of beloved pets waiting on the rainbow bridge.

A devoted Christian, Patty now rests in the arms of her Savior.

She is survived by her high school sweetheart and husband, Richard Wayne McCallum of Odessa; her children: sons, Jarrod Dean Eicher of Gardendale and Jacob Howard Eicher of Odessa; daughter, Jordan Alexis Eicher Linnenkugel of Lubbock and her husband, Nikolus Alan Linnenkugel, and their sons Ayden Nikolus (18), Riley Stephen (15), Nikolus Dean (15), and Hudson Emery (11). She is also survived by Chase Hart of Odessa, whom she loved like and referred to as an adopted son. Patty leaves behind her sister, Lisa Rae Davidson of Poolville, and Lisa's husband, Davy, along with their children Daniel Wayne Davidson of Deming, NM and his daughter, Emma Rose; and Jennifer Nicole Davidson and her fiancé, Clayton Findley; her stepmother, Capel Campbell of Midland; her stepbrother, John Perez of Midland; and her nephew, Caelan Wayne Campbell of Grapevine. She is also survived by countless cherished friends whom she loved like family.
