“ Roger Brentley Crawford 73 of Midland Texas, passed away February 16th of 2024. Mr. Crawford passed away at peace in his sleep from a heart attack. Born January 15, 1951 in Roswell, New Mexico to Marie Elizabeth Graber a nurse at Walker Air Force base from Yale University and Oscar Benton C. an alfalfa farmer and cattle rancher. As a young boy he was taught the art of alfalfa farming and cattle ranching as the oldest of 4 siblings. “Crawford Brothers Farms” was the Pioneering lands of the middle of the 20th century just a few miles north of Roswell, New Mexico about 20 miles east of the famous Roswell UFO crash site and host to a strategic spot on earth during the cold war that housed atlas nuclear missile silos to defend the nation against the threat of nuclear war against the Soviet Union.

A graduate of Goddard High School, Roger went on to study his college education at New Mexico State University. After college he became a real estate broker for Robert O Anderson firm and son - former congressman of New Mexico, Phelps Anderson. Roger went on to become a successful oil and gas broker as president of New Energy and Citigas Corporation of Midland and Arlington, Texas. Roger revolutionized the natural gas industry with a patented natural gas engine called the "Citimotor" that received an award from the department of energy in Washington D.C. The technology is now used in all modern vehicles to help clean up the climate problem of green house gases and climate change from the pollution of fossil fuels in the Earth's atmosphere.

A loving father and compassionate student for the truth, he never failed in providing and leading his peers and friends into different understandings of his quest to find other testaments of Jesus Christ. Roger was a farmer, a rancher, a military cadet, a real estate broker, a natural gas broker, a pilot, a protestant minister, a student of the book of Mormon, and a pivotal link to the nation's security as a member and advisor to the Republican presidential round table in Washington D.C.

*In his later years he created PURE LIFE health and research company. A cancer foundation to study and help cure diseases and cancer. It became a popular site on the internet and a online health store.*

*Roger is survived by his 3 children, Mariasha, Joshua and Jordan. His six grandchildren: Mekelee, Breanna, Brentley Charles, Christian, Kalissa, and Laura. And he got to witness being a great grandfather to a new sibling of his crest, a great grandson named Charles.*

*Roger's greatest quest of success was to comprise thousands of books he collected and read throughout his life in his library throughout the world and he created The New World Foundation, a bible store that offered revised published editions of the bible, the bible 2 and the bible 3.*
