



## Spencer Wayne Fry

March 4, 1980 - November 21, 2014

U.S. Naval Veteran Spencer Wayne Fry joined the Heavenly Host Friday November 21st 2014.

A native of Odessa Texas, Spencer graduated from Odessa High School and then served in the United States Navy for 13 years before being honorably discharged. He served as a Naval Chaplain and received numerous Military Commendations during his service.

Prior to moving to Flower Mound, he was a student at the Art Institute in Los Angeles where he was pursuing a degree in Architectural Design.
